Responsibilities under Integrated Child Protection Scheme (responsibilities of various government departments)

Special Juvenile Police Unit



Present the child to Child Welfare Committee/Juvenile Justice Board/Children's court



Physical and Mental health examination-
Social investigation



Information to be shared with parents/guardians



Filling up form 'M' online



Sending report to the District Legal Services Authority



Conducting further enquiry

Juvenile Justice Board



Taking initiative for rehabilitation process



Directing the police for crimes committed against the child



Ensuring availability of legal aid for the child



Preparation of Individual Care Plan based on the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015

Child Welfare Committee

Keeping the child at a suitable facility/foster care



Ensuring free legal aid services for the child



Informing about restoration and further guidance for the child



Giving notice to other related government departments for necessary action
